It has long been known among the community that the Slate Belt Region lacked affordable addictions treatment programs. Two experienced counselors saw



this need as an opportunity to fulfill their life dream of establishing a local, independent facility that is not only affordable and accessible, but also more importantly, a program that is client driven and effective. In 2005, Recovery Revolution, Inc. (RRI) was born. At the end of 2009, RRI moved into its permanent location so that we can expand services and continue to serve the Slate Belt community.

About us

RRI is a charitable, non-profit organization that is fully licensed by the PA Department of Health, Division of Drug and Alcohol Program Licensure for outpatient and intensive outpatient services. Our mission is to promote healthy, responsible, and individualized treatment for addictions through programs responsive to family and community needs. We are also licensed for treatment of problem gamblers. Recovery Revolution, Inc. has a friendly staff that is comprised of exceptionally experienced, compassionate, and highly educated counselors. All of our clinical staff have 5-22 years of experience working in the Addictions Field and are Bachelor's or Masters Level Certified/Licensed Clinicians.

Services Offered

Level of Care Assessments: Completed by Licensed/Credentialed Staff

Outpatient/Intensive Outpatient: Individual, Group & Family Counseling 1-10 hours per wk, separate programs for adolescents and adults

Outpatient Gambling Treatment: Service provided by certified gambling counselors

Psychiatric Evaluation and Medication Management: Offered by consulting psychiatrist

Random Urine Drug Screening: Utilized as clinical tool only—not for legal purposes

School-Based Outpatient Program: Individual, Group, & Family Counseling directly at Colonial Academy, Wind Gap, PA

School-Based Prevention/Ed Program: In-class sessions focusing on education, coping skills, resources, & healthy decision making

Education for Community & School Professionals: Provide up-to-date information regarding drug trends, addiction traits, recognizing individuals under the influence

Alcohol and Drug Intervention Program: Classes offered to Colleges and other organizations. We will tailor a program specific to your organization's needs

DUI Program: A state-of-the-art 12 hour DUI program facilitated by licensed/credentialed counselors

Parents, Partners, & Loved Ones Program: We offer a 12 hour course for individuals impacted by their loved ones addiction. These classes address topics such as: disease of addiction, codependency, enabling, support systems, helpful tools for their sanity.

Sober Support: Alumni and Active Clients are encouraged to attend planned activities throughout the year to include our Bowling Team! This fosters socialization skills and introduces them to individuals that can support their continued sobriety.

Advanced Parents, Partners, & Loved Ones:

For individuals who have completed our 12 hour program and feel they need more help and support, we have created a follow-up program.

Life Skills Course: We offer an 18 hour course (6 weeks) to assist anyone who would benefit from resume building, banking 101, parenting skills and much more.

Free Community Events: We offer free events every year for the purpose of promoting recovery, educating about addiction, and supporting the community that we serve.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

It is the policy of RRI not to terminate active clients based on lack of finances. We will work with individuals no matter what their financial status. We are currently contracted with Northampton County allowing eligible individuals without insurance to receive treatment. We accept Medical Assistance, Gateway, Ameri-Health Mercy, and Magellan. We are able to work with most private insurance companies and accept self-pay. We also have a sliding fee scale for individuals that are ineligible for any type of funding.
